July 09th: 2nd Day for Blind Football, Goalball & Para Judo Tournaments

July 10th: 3rd Day for Blind Football and Goalball Tournaments and Departure for Para Judo Teams

July 11th: 4th Day for Blind Football Tournament and Departure for Goalball Teams

July 12th: Departure for Blind Football Teams.

1. DEADLINES

Deadline for Classification applications: <u>May 30th 2021</u> six weeks before the first day of the classifications, according to IBSA rules. It is mandatory to manage the entry of athletes using the IBSA ISAS database:

2. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

Tournaments will be played under IBSA Rules. Referees are going to be local referees. If each team requires they can bring one referee by their own cost.

3. INSURANCE

Each IBSA member Federation (in the following: IBSA Member Organisations) is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the control of gender are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, during the events.

The organizer of the event and the IBSA will not be responsible for any insurance related to above-mentioned matters. Nevertheless, the IBSA Member Organisations staging the event shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The organizer of the event and the IBSA has no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising out of the participation and traveling in connection with this event.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

According to the new rules due to the coronavirus pandemic, COVID-19 testing is obligatory and test should be valid for 48 hours before scheduled departure. Please be sure to have a paper copy of your COVID-19 negative individual medical certificate available for inspection at the airport. Please make sure the certificate also has an English version.

A negative COVID-19 test is required for passengers flying to Turkey in order to check-in for their flight.

All team members are responsible for their own safety. All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect one-another.

COVID-19 protocol can be changed so please check all the official documents and letters from the organizers and follow the latest version.

LOC are not responsible for any cost resulting from positive cases such as changing of flight or the accommodation.

All countries will be tested for PCR in the hotel on the day of arrival and also 48 hours before departure.

All the tests will be done in the hotel.

Throughout your stay

1. Wash/sanitize your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object.

Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the contest.

- 2. No handshake greet each other with a bow.
- 3. Wear a mask at all times (change it at least twice a day). Exceptions: masks are not obligatory on the Field of Play, on the warm-up whilst warming up or on whilst training. Masks must be worn in dining areas at all times, except when sitting eating.
- 4. Maintain 1.5 m distance at all times, except for competitors during training and matches.
- 5. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the LOC on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the competition venue and at any official venue of the event, to be accepted by all accredited population. Anyone registering a high temperature will be asked to remain outside and their Delegation COVID-19 Manager, the LOC COVID19 Manager
- 6. Close contact a close contact (for the purpose of isolation/quarantine) is considered as a person

who

is/was:

- Sharing the same hotel room.
- Had face-to-face contact at a distance of less than two meters for more than 15 minutes (i.e. training or warm-up partner).
- Seated together in an aircraft or other means of transport without wearing a mask. In case of a positive test result, we will follow the Turkish Government/Ministry of Health procedure.

Quarantine period: Minimum 10 days (including 1 negative tests)

Quarantine Rates (Full Board per person per night):

Single 100 €

Anyone with a positive test MUST stay in the quarantine hotel provided by the LOC. The cost must be paid by the National Federation.

If a positive person takes another test during the quarantine period:

If positive: Restart quarantine

If negative: Quarantine must be finished

When the quarantine period is over: To leave Turkey without retesting

PCR Tests cost each person each time 70€
